SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Scholarships shall be rewarded by the Burnaby Metro Selects Soccer Club to any successful applicant who, for two or more years, has played with the Burnaby Selects team, a Burnaby resident or played all his soccer in Burnaby
2. Scholarships shall be rewarded to:
 - (a) Students proceeding from Grade 12 to any university in the province or other secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
3. Candidates must complete the application in full and provide all required information, documents and letters in order for their application to be considered.
4. Scholarships are conditional, in that the funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he is attending a post-secondary institute approved by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
5. A candidate must have the proficiency in soccer as indicated by his/her play and/or have shown worthwhile contributions to the sport, as judged by the Scholarship Selection Committee, in the area of refereeing, coaching or club or district administration.
6. A candidate must have a minimum "C" average in his marks.
7. A candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship, character and leadership.
8. The following must accompany the application:
 - (a) A letter from the principal or post-secondary administrator certifying the candidate's age, scholarship, character and ability, as well as participation in school activities.
 - (b) A transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record Card. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the principal's or secondary administrator's signature will be accepted. Current Christmas and Easter marks must be attached.
 - (c) A letter from a team official indicating the candidate's character, leadership examples, participation in community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's soccer ability or contribution to refereeing, coaching or administrative involvement.

PLEASE NOTE

9. It is the responsibility of the candidate to see that the application is complete and that all required information, documentation and letters are enclosed with the application.
10. The Scholarship Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with any scholarship applicant or his agent. The decision of the Committee is final!
